STUDIO POLICIES

Payments

- All accounts are required to have a Visa or MasterCard saved on file. We will automatically process your monthly tuition installments on the 1st of every month. If you prefer to pay with cash, check, or another card, simply do so before the 1st of the month.
- If by some chance the payment fails, you've got until the 10th of the month to complete your tuition installment. After the 10th, a \$15 late fee will be added to your account.
- Recital Costume Payments will be charged on October 15th. You
 will be notified of the price prior to being charged. Costumes are
 a one-time payment and include the costume, a pair of tights,
 and all the accessories!
- For participating Performance Program and Dance Company dancers, Installment Payments will be automatically charged on 9/15, 10/15, 1/15, and 2/15.

Withdrawals & Cancellations

- To withdraw from a class you must notify us at office@fdc.dance before the 1st of the month. You are responsible for all tuition and fees through the date of withdrawal.
- Registration Fees, Tuition, Costume Payments, and Performance Program/Dance Company monthly tuition installments are non-refundable.

Behavior Code

• A strict behavior code for dancers and parents will be followed, which includes absolutely no inappropriate touching, hitting, yelling, or bullying of the other students, parents, staff and faculty. Any student or parent who does not adhere to this rule will immediately be dismissed from the studio.

DRESS CODE

Our professional staff is focused on teaching dance through proper body alignment, injury prevention, and technical progression. Therefore, we stress proper dance attire at all times. The dress code is very cost effective and makes Recital costumes extra special!

Shoes, dance wear, and Fusion-logo items are available at the Fusion Boutique for your convenience!

Ballet, Jazz, Modern, and Lyrical classes:
Hair must be pulled off the face and in a BUN.
All other classes:
Hair must be pulled off the face and in a PONYTAIL.

Fusion's Dress Code varies by class and by age. Please use the QR code below to view the requirements for each of your dancer's classes. Remember, no jeans in any class!



Specific shoes are chosen for each class based on the support they give for children's delicate bones that are appropriate to age and level. **Please note that there are NO STREET SHOES permitted for any dance classes.**

DON'T FORGET!

Dance shoes should never be worn outside of the studio. **Please have your dancer commute in street shoes and change into their dance shoes upon arrival.** We appreciate your assistance in protecting our dance floors! (*Plus your child's dance shoes will last longer!*)

TIPS FOR THE BEST EXPERIENCE



Fusion does not have a water fountain or vending machines. Please send your dancer with a labeled water bottle. Limited edition Fusion drinkware and Auto-Top bottles for kids are available at the Fusion Boutique!



Classes will start and end on time. Dancers should be dropped off no more than ten minutes before the start of class. Upon arrival, dancers should change into their dance shoes, use the bathroom, and line up outside of their assigned studio.



Fusion has two single-occupancy restrooms located in the front of the building, including one with a changing table.



There is a large rear parking lot with an entrance to the studio that can be accessed via a driveway on either side of the building. Please note that the driveway nearest to Fusion is Enter Only. To exit onto W Westfield Ave, please continue to the further, wider driveway.

21ST SEASON CALENDAR

Fusion's calendar has inclement weather closings allotted for each day of the week. If we go beyond the allotted closings, make-up classes will be scheduled.

As a reminder, tuition is calculated based on the full dance season, accounting for holidays and snow days. These installments do not vary with short or long months, school recesses, or anticipated vacations since they are calculated on a yearly basis and conveniently divided into 9.5 monthly installments.

Participation in Recital is optional but highly encouraged as dance is a performing art, and most dancers do participate!

Recital is like the "graduation ceremony" of the year where the combination of weekly dance technique, focused performance skills, and hard work are celebrated on the big stage! It is a special day for families and dancers to take pride in how far their child has grown and to create memories that they will look back on fondly in future years.

COSTUME PAYMENTS

Due: October 15th. The cost of your dancer's costume will be emailed to you before your account is charged. *Costume Payments are non-refundable.*

Includes: Costume, a new pair of tights, all accessories—everything they need for stage!

FYI: Costumes <u>will not be ordered</u> <u>without payment</u>, and late orders may be subject to additional shipping charges.

COSTUME & RECITAL TIMELINE

- September-October Teachers begin planning music and dance themes for each class.
- October Fusion's Costume Team begins measuring dancers in class.
- October 15th Costume payments due.
- October November Final costume selections are made. Dancers are sized according to measurements and thousands of costumes are ordered!
- December-February Costumes are made in factories across the country.
- January 2025 Recital Information & Handbooks are highlighted & mailed to your home.
- January April Dancers are hard at work learning their recital choreography!
- March Costume deliveries begin. Fusion's Costume Team organizes all the costumes by class to try on.
- March-April Costumes are tried on in class and exchanged for different sizes if needed. Then they are steamed, bagged, organized with brand new tights, accessories, and labels before being distributed to you!
- May-June TBD Dress Rehearsals, photos. Dancers are performing their dances in front of fellow student audiences to gain support and confidence
- **Date and Location TBD** 21st Annual Recital
